## Principal's Message

### Use of Technology-At Home

The AAP (American Academy of Pediatrics) recommends no screen time (TV, phone, iPad, etc) for children under two and then limiting screen time to under an hour. The academy allows some video-chatting as a form of communication with family.

In his book "The Tech-Wise Family", Andy Crouch calls for families to see technology as a useful tool which should be used deliberately and purposefully not frivolously to kill time. Mr. Crouch and the AAP agree, media-free times (such as dinner and an hour before bed), ensure that we get rest from our devices.

Creating guidelines for how devices will be used in your home allow you to decide your family's values. Some family guidelines may include:

1. No phones during dinner (includes parents).
2. No phones/computers in bedrooms starting an hour before bed (or ever!)
3. Parents may check/confiscate any form of technology at any time for any reason.
4. Set aside time to make and create together (music, art, cake, rebuilding an engine, etc).
5. Take time to read which improves learning and comprehension.
