### Technology

The internet offers a great number of resources for learning and entertainment; however, technology also provides opportunities for children to see and experience bad things.

From time to time, the news reports a number of dangerous challenges that children (and sometimes adults) attempt. To report on any and every evil present on the internet would be impossible. As a school, St. Paul's Lutheran works to teach students best practices while using technology at school and at home; however, the most important aspect of protecting your child remains supervision. A few things to keep in mind:

1. **Know what your child watches:**  
While it may be easy to simply hand your child a device and let them watch Youtube, keep in mind that many videos may be inappropriate for them to watch.
2. **Know what your child plays:**  
Some games contain graphic images and violence.
3. **Know who/how your child communicates:** Children may connect with bad people.
4. **Check your child's devices/apps often.**
