Carline Procedure Reminder

NOTE: The following does not change any policy or procedure. I only hope to clarify for the safety of all involved!

In the morning, please join the carline by turning right off of 5th Street.

During the afternoon carline, please remember to be attentive. For the safety of students and staff, please put your phone away while your car is moving through the line. Also, remember that if you are the first car in a rotation to pull up to where Mr. Poppe is standing. Once you have reached your stopping spot, please remain in "PARK" until the car in front of you begins to move. **If someone unfamiliar with carline is dropping off or picking your child up, please remind them of these procedures as well!**

We continue to release walkers in all directions after completion of the carline for safety reasons. We aim to finish the carline between 3:35-3:40 PM; however, some circumstances cause delays such as athletic games/practices, the number of bus riders, and weather.
