Christmas Cards

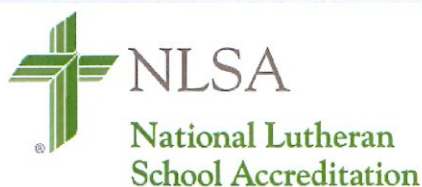
The St. Paul's Grade School has
