Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year is now open! St. Paul's Lutheran Church and School website (www.stpaulsconcordia.org) includes enrollment forms under school forms. The front side includes Enrollment, Technology, and Tuition Fees. If you plan on applying for Financial Assistance please indicate on the enrollment form. The reverse side includes information about the sports, band, lunches, bus, and Extended Care fees. You do **NOT** need to fill out the back when enrolling. Return all forms to the school office.

The Lutheran School Board voted to keep enrollment, technology, and other fees (Sports, Lunch, Band, EC) the same in 2021-2022. Adjustments were made to the form for PS/PK in order to provide consistency. We will also be adding PK 3 full-day and 3 half-day options. Please note that for the safety of your child, Extended Care will be closed on days when school is closed for inclement weather. Extended Care will also be closed for indicated holidays. Also note, Financial Aid Forms are due by August 15th this year in order to inform families earlier of any award money.

The cost per child at St. Paul's Lutheran School averaged \$6,800.00 during 2020-2021. St. Paul's member tuition for 2020-2021 will remain at \$130.00 per child per month (1st & 2nd child only) to meet the NLSA goal of the members paying 20% of the annual tuition cost while the congregation pays 80%.

Tuition for Other Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod (LCMS) congregation members remain at \$506.00 per month per child (\$5,060.00 per year). For information about financial support from your LCMS congregation, please check with your congregational leadership. St. Paul's Lutheran Church will continue to subsidize the remaining \$1,300.00 for members of LCMS churches who send their child(ren) to St. Paul's Lutheran School.

Tuition for community members will remain at \$540.00 per month per child (\$5,400.00 per year). St. Paul's Lutheran Church will subsidize the remaining \$1,025.00 per student to assist families in the community who send their child(ren) to St. Paul's Lutheran School.

A 10% reduction for tuition (Enrollment, Technology, and other fees are not reduced) will be applied when tuition fees are paid in full by April 15, 2020. A 5% reduction for tuition will be applied when tuition is paid in full from April 16 to May 15.

Please contact the school office if you have any questions or need assistance filling out the enrollment form. We look forward to teaching your child this coming year!
